

Confirmation Covenant

Confirmation is a ministry of the church, which helps the baptized child to identify more deeply with the Christian community and participate more fully in the life of the church.

To accomplish our goals and expectations for the confirmation program at Our Savior's Lutheran Church, the following guidelines have been established:

1. Attend Confirmation Camp or complete all material covered at camp.
2. Attend scheduled Wednesday classes. If the student misses a week they need to look up the lesson and complete the online lesson. If the student misses more than three times, they are required to schedule a make-up session with Pastor Dan.
3. Attend Sunday worship a *minimum* of two times each month.
4. Fill out a minimum of 22 Worship/Sermon note forms (These will be used to record your worship attendance – 16 Sunday services plus 6 Wednesday services during Lent)
5. Attend Sunday or Wednesday School a *minimum* of two times each month. A facilitator will contact students regarding make-up sessions or service projects for classes missed. 9th Graders may participate in the following ministries in place of Sunday/Wednesday school: 10:30 Song leading team, Ushering team, Sound Technician for 10 services, Shepherd for Sunday School, Youth Ministry Team, Visual Arts Team, Altar Preparation Team, Hand bells, Gospel Ensemble. If you are going to participate this way you must inform Pastor Dan and make contact with the appropriate person in charge. Other alternatives could be considered.
6. Participate in at least two service projects.
7. Complete assigned memory work from Luther's Small Catechism. (8th graders: 10 Commandments, Apostle's Creed, 9th graders: Lord's Prayer, Communion, Baptism)
8. 8th graders participate in the Adopt-a-grandparent program and 9th graders participate in the Mentor program (both happen during Lent).
